10. FOOD:

The Association will provide and protein- meat and vegetarian substitutes. Potluck dishes will have to be a complete salad, casserole etc. not just chips or a cucumber for example.

The K.C.S.F. (Kootenay Continuing Sustainable Future Group) has expressed an interested in co-ordinating the food - meaning the preparation and putting out for eating). The group are Janie Lewis, Evie Smith, Deborah Stinsman, and Laurie ?. We are still confirming this.

One to two women are still needed to be the over-all co-ordinators of the food organization. Also we are looking for a kitchen co-ordinator and a dish-washer co-ordinator.
