Friday night a bonfire and sing-a-long will start off the week-end. Workshops on Saturday are centered around this year's theme. ' THE FORBIDDEN FESTIVAL'. Topics for the workshops include Women and Power(on women and leadership), To See OURSELVES (a little workshop that's big on body image), Rediscovering our Playfulness, A Women's Quest (a workshop on Spirituality), Homophobia (breaking down the barriers between heterosexuals and lesbians), and Rethinking the Revolution (focusing on key issues and developing workable strategies. A barbacue, vegetarian and non-vegetarian, Saturday night will be followed by a Theatre Sports performance and then we'll bogie into the night. Theatre, music, poetry and hopefully a singing workshop and performance by the Images Ad Hoc Singers will highlight Sunday's four hour Stage. Other events include an Arts and Crafts Bazaar, Children's activities, camping, swimming and lots of guaranteed sunshine.
